Synopsis

At each destination we will learn crucial lessons to help us apply surface and deep level knowledge about individuals from various cultural geographic regions to our clinical practices. Ultimately, we will end our trip appreciating the diversity in the cultures of neuropsychology internationally, as well as the diversity in the people that neuropsychology serves around the world.
